In addition to the usual Windsor/Poquonock names like Holcomb and Griswold, it is interesting to see Irish names, like Patrick Faylon, Michael Fitzgerald, and Richard Norris (notations are made concerning the hiring of people with Irish surnames.) This book probably belonged to Eli Phelps, Jr. (1807-1879) of Poquonock, a farmer and Windsor Representative to the Connecticut Legislature.
