**Michelle Tom**

OK. Can you start by telling us your name and how long you've lived in Windsor?

**Jordan Stillman**

My name is Jordan Stillman and I have lived in Windsor most of my life.

When I was two months old.

So you don't remember much. And where do you go to school?

**Michelle Tom**

And do you like it there?

**Jordan Stillman**

Yes, I do.

What grade are you in?

**Jordan Stillman**

I am in fifth.

**Michelle Tom**

What's your teacher's name?

**Jordan Stillman**

Ms. Bowman and Ms. Paley.

**Colette Yeich**

What do you like to do for fun?

**Jordan Stillman**

Play soccer.

**Colette Yeich**

Ah, just like your brother.

**Jordan Stillman**

Yep.

**Colette Yeich**

Are you on a team?

**Jordan Stillman**

No, but I played it for a team a long time ago.

Any other sports? Do you play any other sports?

**Jordan Stillman**

No.

So what [00:01:00] else would you do? Are you on the computer a lot?

**Jordan Stillman**

Eh.

**Michelle Tom**

Are there any places you like to go eat in town?

**Jordan Stillman**

Well, there's not a lot of places. But one place I do like to go to is Dom's.

**Michelle Tom**

What do you get there?

**Jordan Stillman**

Usually just breakfast stuff.

**Colette Yeich**

So what's school like?

**Jordan Stillman**

So in the morning, I usually go to my homeroom, which is room 19, and I stay there until 9:30 in the morning. Then I go to math until my lunchtime at 11. And then I do writing until 1:45, and then at 2:30, I go to math. And then at the end of the day, I go back to my homeroom and wait there until my bus is called.

So what do you like about Windsor?

I like that there's a lot of places and I like that – it's like all the [00:03:00] things I know.

Have you been here before?

**Jordan Stillman**

Yes, I have.

**Michelle Tom**

Oh, what did you do here?

**Jordan Stillman**

Well, I went to that one Montessori School, which is right behind here, and yeah. And I've been here for like some sort of stuff.

Have you been to field trips here?

**Jordan Stillman**

Nah. No.

**Ms. Stillman**
