

Tuesday, September 26th is the Town of Windsor's 345th birthday. Our Historical Society will meet at 8:00 p. m. for its annual meeting and election of officers. Come prepared to take notes for our guest speaker, George E. Williams of the Connecticut Genealogical Society will give us some tips on what an individual can do to start some genealogical investigation for himself.

The Windsor Garden Club has invited all members of the Historical Society to attend their next meeting which will take place at the Historical Society headquarters October 9th at 8:00 p. m. A lecture entitled, "Gardens of the New Nation" will be given by Rudy J. Favretti, professor of Landscape Architecture at the University of Connecticut. He will recreate, through slides, early American gardens with the emphasis on the Fyler House period. As we informed you in a previous newsletter the Garden Club is designing and planting an 18th century herb and flower garden at the Fyler House. They expect to have this well planted by fall. Please take the time to notice the old stone walk in the southeast corner of Fyler House. This was raised from beneath the surface of the ground where it had been buried for many years. We owe thanks to the hard working Garden Club members who are working on this project.

Much activity has taken place in the Fyler House and Wilson Museum during the summer. Tourists from all over the Nation continue to find their way to our door for tours and also to do genealogical research in our library.

The Victorian corner in the Museum basement has been moved to the top floor. To make the room authentic Mrs. Blake would like some old lace curtains of the Victorian period. If anyone has a pair or two, please call Mrs. C. Edgar Blake or the Historical Society Office.

The space formerly occupied by the Victorian furniture now contains an old weaving loom which Mrs. Warren Ball plans to actually put to use before the end of the year.
