The winter meeting of the Society will be on Wednesday, December 10th at 8:00 p.m. in the Wilson Museum. There will be a performance by Robert Olson, who is on the staff of Old Sturbridge Village. He calls the show "Richard Potter, 19th Century Magician." The show is done in an early 19th century costume, using the patter and props that come from Potter's own period.
